

Assisting rural and remote schools in Western Australia with the Forrest Foundation.



The brief.

Education Changemakers was approached by the Forrest Foundation to support teacher retention and effectiveness across rural and remote regions of Western Australia.

What we did.

We focused on supporting educators in the identified rural and remote schools to drive teacher-led innovations. The goal of this work was to support educators to develop locally inspired solutions, tailored to the unique realities of the communities we were working in. Across a three year period, each cohort of educators engaged in five workshop days with ongoing support to help them build out their change projects.
